In accordance with a letter of agreement between Los Angeles College Faculty Guild - Local 1521, hereinafter referred to as CLIENT and the American Arbitration Association, hereinafter referred to as A.A.A., an Election of Officers was conducted among the membership of the union. As a result of the initial tally on May 2, 2018, a Run-Off election became necessary in the East Campus Executive Board Delegates, the Mission Campus Chapter President, and the Districtwide Recording Secretary positions.

Four thousand one hundred seventeen (4,117) ballots were mailed to the members of the CLIENT on May 7, 2018. During the course of the election, one (1) additional member was added and nine (9) changes of address and/or requested duplicates were mailed out. In order for the ballots to be valid and counted, the franked, return envelopes, furnished to the members, were required to be received by the Post Office by 12:00 midnight, Tuesday, May 29, 2018.

The CLIENT provided the A.A.A. with an alphabetical list of persons who were eligible to vote. The counting of the ballots took place at the A.A.A. offices at 725 S. Figueroa St., Suite 400, Los Angeles, California on Wednesday, May 30, 2018. Secrecy of the ballot was maintained at all times.
